Your Roadmap to a Powerful, IRS-Approved Mission Statement







Your mission statement is the foundation of your 501(c)(3) application. The IRS will review it closely to determine if you qualify for tax-exempt status. This worksheet will help you craft a mission statement that clearly communicates your purpose while meeting all IRS requirements.

WHAT MAKES A GREAT 501(C)(3) MISSION STATEMENT?

- Clear charitable purpose Must explicitly serve public good
- Specific enough to guide your work
- **Broad enough** to allow growth
- IRS-compliant language that demonstrates exempt purpose
- Memorable and inspiring for donors and volunteers

COMMON MISTAKES TO AVOID

- Being too vague ("help the community")
- Being too narrow (limiting future programs)
- Missing exempt purpose language
- Including non-exempt activities
- Making it too long or complex

STEP 1 - DEFINE YOUR "WHAT"

STEP 2 - DEFINE YOUR "WHO"	
Who do you serve? (Be specific but not too narrow)	
Example: Middle and high school students in low-income neighborhoods	
What geographic area?	
Example: Greater Chicago area	
STEP 4 - DEFINE YOUR "WHY"	
What change will you create?	
Example: Increase college readiness and career opportunities in technolog	<i>ĵy</i>
How does this benefit the public?
